



## **SURVIVAL AND ATTRITION RATES OF JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS IN THE DIVISION OF QUEZON SY: 2015-2018 AS BASIS FOR A PROPOSED INTERVENTION PROGRAM**

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### **ABSTRACT**

This research focused on the development of a proposed attrition and survival intervention program for the Division of Quezon. The researcher used descriptive research with Grades 7 to 10 students. Based on the results of the study, the highest contributory factor to attrition rate is peer pressure and the contributory factor to survival is family aspect. Under guidance and counseling, it was agreed that the class adviser should strictly monitor students' attendance; while to the other school programs, it extrapolated that the top scorer is the item illustrating that "The school conducts regular PTA conferences to let parents know the status of their kids in school". It was agreed that the material used should contain a table of contents to find the topic easily. The study recommends to closely monitor and supervise the enrolment of the students in the schools. Counseling, quality time, and motivation from the members of the family and the school should also be considered.
