ABSTRACT

The Discord application has been determined as one of the primary online communication platforms used during the pandemic for online events and meetings. This research study aims to determine and evaluate the lived-experiences of students in using Discord in organizational events and meetings. The specific objectives of this research study are to determine the essential features of Discord used in facilitating organizational meetings, the implications of Discord among selected participants of Letran-Bataan, and the activity plan that can be proposed to spread awareness towards the use of Discord in facilitating organizational meetings. The study is limited to the members of the Society of Psychology Students from the collegiate department of Colegio de San Juan de Letran-Bataan. Criterion sampling was utilized to determine the sample size that was used by the research study. Through the utilization of thematic analysis, the findings of the research study revealed that the common perceptions of the participants are that Discord demonstrates practical features in terms of communication and that it incites the respondents to participate more in organizational meetings. Furthermore, it was determined that Discord is generally perceived to be a better online communication platform for organizational events and meetings.
